- Altar Servers** - The server assists the presider; prepares the altar; makes sure that what is needed for the celebration is brought, carried, or moved into place.
- Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion** - An Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion is a layperson formally instituted to distribute Holy Communion during Mass.
- Lector** - Lectors strive to make the Liturgy of the Word as meaningful as possible for the worshipping assembly. After proper instruction, the Lectors proclaim the Word of God for our weekend liturgies.
- Usher** - The usher greets you, helps you find a seat, passes the collection baskets, distributes the bulletin, helps and ensures an orderly process during the Sacrament of the Eucharist.
- Greeter** - welcome our guests to church. Need to be here 30 minutes prior to the start of Mass and stand in the entrance to the church.
